# **UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS**

### Saint Mary MacKillop Colleges, Wagga Wagga

Students are requested to wear school uniform at all times, unless a special program or event is taking place at school (in this event prior notice will be given to students and parents). Cleanliness and neatness are promoted as part of Christian character formation.

Blazers are to be worn travelling to and from school in Terms 2&3 by Years 5 to 12. A black jumper can be worn for extra warmth, but must not be worn to and from school without the blazer. They are to be worn on special formal occasions such as School Assembly and Mass. Blazers are optional in Terms 1 and 4.

**Sun hats** must be worn from F - Year 12 during breaks and when exposed to the sun. Primary and Secondary school maroon hats are now available at the Uniform Shop.

Summer Uniforms are worn in Terms 1 and 4; Winter Uniforms are worn in Terms 2 and 3.

## GIRLS YRS K-10

#### Summer

- A regulation summer uniform is to be worn in Terms 1 & 4 (available from school shop).
   The length of the dress should not be above the knee.
- White regulation ankle socks
- Polished black lace-up shoes or strap over shoes at the ankle, but no ballet flats or shoes with patterns or designs
- Regulation Panama hats are to be worn to and from school, and during all formal occasions, including Mass.

### Winter

- A regulation pinafore is to be worn in Terms
  2 & 3. The length of the pinafore should not be above the knee.
- Long sleeved white 'Peter Pan' collar blouse, school cross-over attached to top button.
- Black pantyhose and polished black lace-up shoes or strap over shoes at the ankle, but no ballet flats or shoes with patterns or designs.
- All girls are to wear regulation Panama hats to and from school.
- Years 5-12: Blazers are worn to and from school. (*K-4 students are not required to wear blazers.*) See top of Page 1 for details.

### **SPORT'S UNIFORM**

- maroon/gold polo top (loose-fitting)
- maroon skort
- White regulation socks
- Runners predominantly white.

### YRS 11-12

Girls in Yrs 11&12 wear the 'Peter Pan' collar blouse, school cross-over attached to the top button. They are also expected to wear a black vest at all times. Skirts are not to be worn above the knees. Panama hats are to be worn to and from school, and at all formal occasions including Liturgical functions.

### Other

**Hair** must not be dyed, must be well groomed and tied back off the face in a low style (so as to be worn under the hat), if it is below the shoulders. Maroon **ribbons**, maroon or black hair bands, and only maroon, black or clear hair clips are worn with the uniform.

Jewellery: In case of pierced ears, one pair of plain gold or silver studs may be worn. No sleepers are permitted for safety reasons. Make-up/nail polish and other jewellery are not permitted. Crucifixes and medals may be worn "invisibly" for safety reasons under blouses. They must be removed if the wearing of them proves unsafe. No tattoos are allowed.

Only **watches** with plain, dark-coloured wristbands are permitted.

## BOYS YEARS K-12

### Summer: Primary F-6

- · Regulation grey shorts
- · Grey long socks
- · Short-sleeved shirt
- School tie
- They are also expected to wear a black belt with the shorts (exception for Foundation, if needed)
- Hats on Playground.

### Summer: Secondary 7-12

- Dark grey trousers
- Black belt- the belt must be black with a simple buckle. Brown belts and buckles with insignia are not acceptable.
- A school regulation tie (to be worn at all times during School day)
- White short-sleeve shirt
- Black polished school shoes
- Black or grey socks

### Winter: Years F-12

- Dark grey trousers
- black belt
- · long white sleeved shirt
- regulation school tie
- Black polished school shoes
- Black or grey long socks
- Years 5-12: Blazers are worn to and from school. (*K-4 students are not required to wear blazers.*) See top of Page 1 for details.

### SPORT'S UNIFORM

#### Summer

- maroon/gold polo top
- black shorts
- white regulation socks/ predominantly white runners

### Winter

- black top
- black tracksuit pants
- White socks/predominantly white runners.

### Other

- It is the boys' responsibility to be clean and tidy. They are to be clean-shaven. Hair must be cut according to College regulations (see below).
- They are to be correctly dressed, including shirt tucked-in at all times and tie neatly tied around the collar. Only a white t-shirt or singlet can be worn under the shirt.
- No jewellery is to be worn. Crucifixes and medals on chains may be worn "invisibly" for safety reasons under shirts. They must be removed if the wearing of them proves unsafe.
- Only watches with plain, dark-coloured wristbands are permitted.
- No tattoos are allowed.

### Hair:

Hair must not be over the collar, ears or eyebrows, Nor should it be overly full at the back or front. It must be cut to the shape of the neck and not in a "fashion style". An all over short haircut is acceptable to a minimum No.2 cut.

Dyeing of hair is not permitted, nor is any kind of hair gel (unless used to control hair) or hair colour allowed under any circumstances. Sideburns may be no longer than mid ear.
