



UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Students are requested to wear school uniform at all times, unless a special program or event is taking place at school (in this event prior notice will be given to students and parents). Cleanliness and neatness are promoted as part of Christian character formation.

Blazers are to be worn travelling to and from school in Terms 2 and 3 by Years 5 to 12. A black jumper can be worn for extra warmth, but must not be worn to and from school without the blazer. They are to be worn on special formal occasions such as School Assembly and Mass. Blazers are optional in Terms 1 and 4.

Regulation Sun hats* must be worn from F – Year 12 during breaks and when exposed to the sun.

Summer Uniforms* are worn in Terms 1 and 4; **Winter Uniforms*** are worn in Terms 2 and 3.

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GIRLS

No colours. Socks may be white or black (no colours or patterns).

Summer

- A regulation summer uniform* is to be worn in Terms 1 & 4. The length of the dress should not be above the knee.
- White regulation quarter-calf socks
- Polished black lace-up shoes or strap over shoes at the ankle (no ballet flats or shoes with patterns/designs).
- Regulation Panama hats* are to be worn to and from school, and during all formal occasions, including Mass.

Winter

- A regulation pinafore* is to be worn in Terms 2 & 3. The length of the pinafore must not be above the knee.
- Long sleeved white 'Peter Pan' collar blouse, school cross-over* attached to top button.
- Black pantyhose and polished black lace-up shoes or strap over shoes at the ankle (no ballet flats or shoes with patterns/designs).
- Regulation Panama hats* are to be worn to and from school, and during all formal occasions, including Mass.
- Years 5-12: Blazers are worn to and from school. (K-4 students are not required to wear blazers.)

SPORT'S UNIFORM

- maroon/gold polo top (loose-fitting)
- maroon skort (Winter: black tracksuit pants)
- Shoes and Socks
 - Primary School: Runners must be predominantly white with white sports socks.
 - Secondary School: Runners must be shades of Black, Grey, White or Brown.

HAIR

Hair must not be dyed, must be well groomed and tied back off the face in a low style (so as to be worn under the hat), if it is below the shoulders. Maroon ribbons, maroon or black hair bands, and only maroon, black or clear hair clips are worn with the uniform.

JEWELLERY

In case of pierced ears, one pair of plain gold or silver studs may be worn. No sleepers are permitted for safety reasons. Make-up/nail polish and other jewellery are not permitted. Crucifixes and medals may be worn "invisibly" for safety reasons under blouses. They must be removed if the wearing of them proves unsafe. No tattoos are allowed.

WATCHES

Only watches with plain, dark-coloured wristbands are permitted.

Girls – Years 11-12

Girls in Yrs 11&12 wear the 'Peter Pan' collar blouse, school cross-over attached to the top button. They are also expected to wear a black vest at all times. Skirts must not be worn above the knees. Panama hats are to be worn to and from school, and at all formal occasions including Liturgical functions.

BOYS

Summer

Primary F-6

- Regulation grey shorts with black belt and simple buckle (Foundation students may be excepted).
- Grey long socks
- White short-sleeved shirt
- School tie*
- Hats* on Playground.

Secondary 7-12

- Dark grey trousers
- Black belt with a simple buckle. (Brown belts and buckles with insignia are not acceptable.)
- Regulation school tie* (to be worn at all times during School day)
- White short-sleeve shirt
- Black polished school shoes
- Black or grey socks

Winter: Years F-12

- Dark grey trousers
- Black belt (See above)
- White long-sleeved shirt
- Regulation school tie*
- Black polished school shoes
- Black or grey long socks
- Years 5-12: Blazers are worn to and from school. Blazers are not permitted on playground. (K-4 students are not required to wear blazers.)

GENERAL

Shirts must be tucked in at all times and tie neatly tied around the collar. Only a white t-shirt or singlet can be worn under the shirt.

SPORT'S UNIFORM

- Maroon/gold polo top (Winter: black jumper may be added)
- Black shorts (Winter: black tracksuit pants)
- Shoes and Socks
 - Primary School: Runners must be predominantly white with white sports socks.
 - Secondary School: Runners must be shades of Black, Grey, White or Brown. No colours. Socks may be white or black (no colours or patterns).

HAIR

It is the boys' responsibility to be clean and tidy. They are to be clean-shaven, and sideburns must be no longer than mid-ear. Hair must be cut according to College regulations.

Hair must not be over the collar, ears or eyebrows, nor should it be overly full at the back or front. It must be cut to the shape of the neck and not in a "fashion style". An all over short haircut is acceptable to a **minimum** No.2 cut.

Dyeing of hair is not permitted, nor is any kind of hair gel (unless used to control hair) or hair colour allowed under any circumstances.

JEWELLERY

No jewellery is to be worn. Crucifixes and medals on chains may be worn "invisibly" for safety reasons under shirts. They must be removed if the wearing of them proves unsafe.

WATCHES

Only watches with plain, dark-coloured wristbands are permitted.

No tattoos are allowed.
